General membership meeting

On Monday 8 April, the annual general membership meeting was held in our regular meeting place, Under the Tower. We had a nice turnout. 23 people gathered to talk together about the affairs of the club. We as a board are very happy about that, because we can use all the input we can get for the best possible policy. What I personally as chairman am also very happy about is that many younger members were also present. This is something I have not often experienced. This created a nice mix of young and old, with the result that most age categories were represented.

Soon, we went through the annual report together with all those present. After some questions and comments, the general annual report was approved by the members. Next, the annual financial report was gone through and approved, again with the necessary feedback and questions from the members. We also discussed next year's budget.

Also on the agenda was the proposal to merge the categories of minis and youth. After voting on this, it was decided to leave it as it is.

Another important point of the meeting was about a contribution increase proposed by the board. The board came up with this proposal due to the expected increase in costs for hall rental in the future. After an initially positive vote, it was decided by the board to suspend this decision. Reference was made by members to a memo showing that with a large reserve, no increase is needed. This is currently (thankfully) the case. The board did not have this document at the time of the meeting. Fortunately, it now does. After meeting separately with the board, it was decided to leave the contribution in place for the time being and first draw up a policy plan for the coming years to better substantiate the possible need for a contribution increase.

Then the treasury committee reported and gave its approval. This approval was followed by another important moment, namely Berton's farewell. That this farewell would come was already known, but it is always a pity to see a good director leave. After a vote of thanks and a present, Patrick's appointment came up. With 0 votes against, he was therefore appointed the new treasurer.

Finally, a new audit committee was elected. Patrick may no longer be a member of the audit committee now that he is treasurer, and Erik's term has expired. The treasury committee will consist of three new powers: Tom Kuiper, Daan Kuik and Koen te Witt.

After this election, all those present were given the opportunity to ask questions. Finally, we ended the evening with drinks in Onder de Toren.


